

## TERRANCE M. BEDIENT, FACHE

Terrance M. Bedient, FACHE, is Vice President of the Medical Society of the State of New York and has been Executive Director of the Committee for Physician Health since 1997. With a Masters in Counseling, Mr. Bedient became a licensed therapist before joining the Army and serving as a Captain in the Medical Service Corps.
