Dr. Gina Del Savio is an orthopedic hand surgeon who joined the SLCH family after completing a Hand and Microsurgery fellowship at Columbia Presbyterian in 1996.

She and her husband raised their 2 sons in Cornwall, while she and her partner grew their orthopedics and sports medicine practice in New Windsor until 2018, when they merged with CRHC.

Del Savio has chaired multiple committees and held multiple medical staff leadership roles both in the hospital and in the community including medical staff president at SLCH, and president of the Orange County Medical Society.

In 2015 she became a Certified Physician Executive through the Certifying Commission in Medical Management of the American Association for Physician Executives and took the position as Associate CMO at SLCH where Dr. Del Savio was a proponent of physician engagement in the strategic process of selecting a health system partner for SLCH. In 2018, Dr. Del Savio became the Chief Medical Officer.

During her tenure, Del Savio established the graduate medical program in collaboration with Touro College of Osteopathic Medicine, revitalized the cancer center on the Cornwall campus, stabilized the SLCH medical group, and led a value analysis approach to supply chain with engagement of physicians.

Although she continues her hand surgery work part time, Dr. Del Savio currently sits on the board of the Hudson Valley IPA, chairs the IPA credentials committee and is a member of the IPA Quality Committee where she works with the Montefiore care management team on ways to improve the healthcare of the population that the Montefiore Health System serves.
